UConn’s Advanced Business Certificate (ABC) program is designed to meet the specialized needs of experienced professionals, managers and executives who have already earned a Master’s, Doctorate, Doctor of Medicine or Juris Doctorate degree. The program is designed to provide instruction in specific subject areas that are important for an individual’s job performance and career development, and represent a substantial learning experience at the graduate level.

Delivered through UConn’s MBA program, the ABC program consists of a group of four related courses (12 credits) selected by the student to fill his or her advanced educational needs. At least three of these courses (9 credits) must be electives in the MBA program. Accordingly, because these courses are advanced post graduate courses, it may be necessary for the student to satisfy any prerequisites for these courses.

Certificates are offered in several areas, including **Accounting, Finance, IT, International Business, Management, Marketing** and **Real Estate**. Each area of study is virtually equivalent to a major concentration. Thus, completion of an ABC is evidence of a high level of competence in the chosen area of advanced academic work. Additionally, students who wish may apply their ABC coursework towards an MBA degree at UConn.

ADMISSION INFORMATION

Advanced Business Certificate applicants may apply to the program at any time during the year. Courses begin in the fall, spring and winter. To qualify for admission, applicants must have a graduate degree (PhD, MD, JD, Master’s) from a fully accredited college or university.

APPLICATION INFORMATION

Applications to the ABC program are accepted on a rolling basis. The ABC application can be found online at www.business.uconn.edu/abc. Applicants will also need the following:

- A current resume
- Official transcripts from each college or university attended (*in English*)
- Personal letter of intent explaining professional goals and expectations of the ABC program
