The Department of Operations and Information Management at UConn's School of Business is seeking opportunities for paid internship positions for MIS majors who will have completed at least their junior year. Our students are motivated and possess a solid background in IT. While individual coursework and skill sets vary, these students will typically have completed courses in basic MIS, data structures/database design, and basic programming. Many will also have taken network analysis, VB, and a variety of electives. We seek positions in which our students, in addition to applying their immediate knowledge, are able to expand their learning and practical experience.

To enhance the success of internships, the program includes academic credit and involves all of the following: formal and required pre-internship preparation sessions, on-campus interview opportunities for participating companies, faculty oversight including on-site visits (if of interest to employer), post-internship reviews, and academic report/research paper evaluation. The course/credit structure of the internship program has also been designed to accommodate semester-long co-op programs.

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
